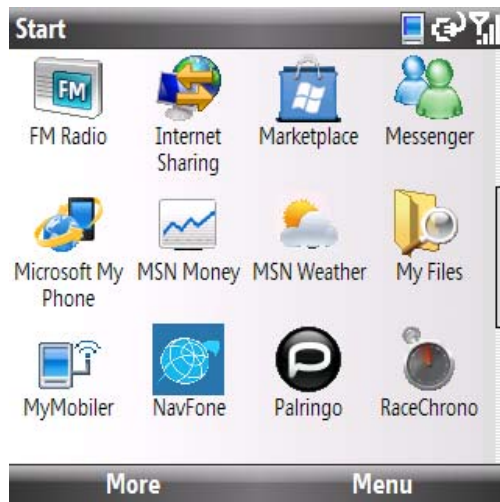

1.1 Installing NAVFone

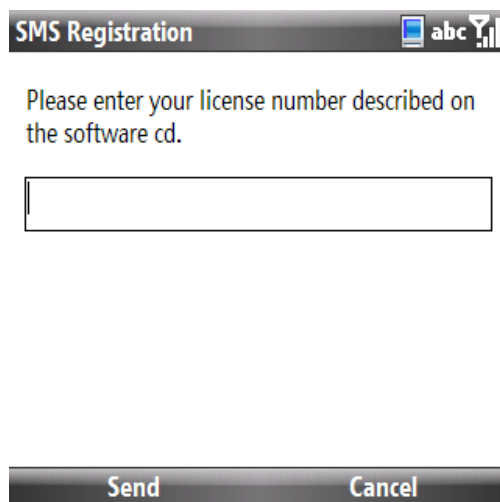
Please refer to the NAVFone Activation Guide included in the phone packaging.

2.0 Using NAVFone

2.1 Launching the application & activation




Go into **Start Menu > More > NAVFone**



Enter License number and then press Send. Please wait a while the SMS Activation is being process.

This can be obtained from the NAVFone scratch card provided. (Take note it is case sensitive)

The activation is done via SMS. Normal SMS charges apply.

3.0 The Map View window

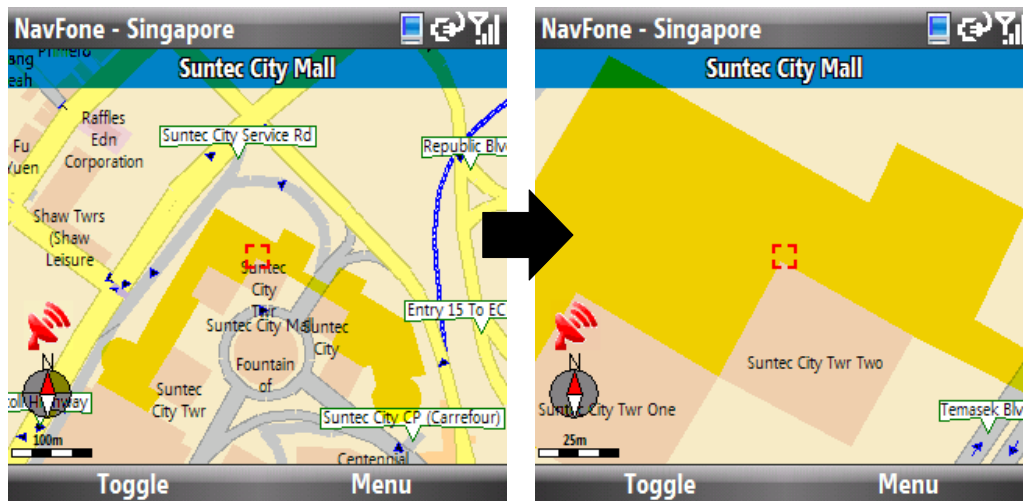


The Map View shows the main screen.

All maps shown are always orientated to the North. The scale on the bottom left changes according to the zoom level and provides a rough estimate of distances between places and objects.

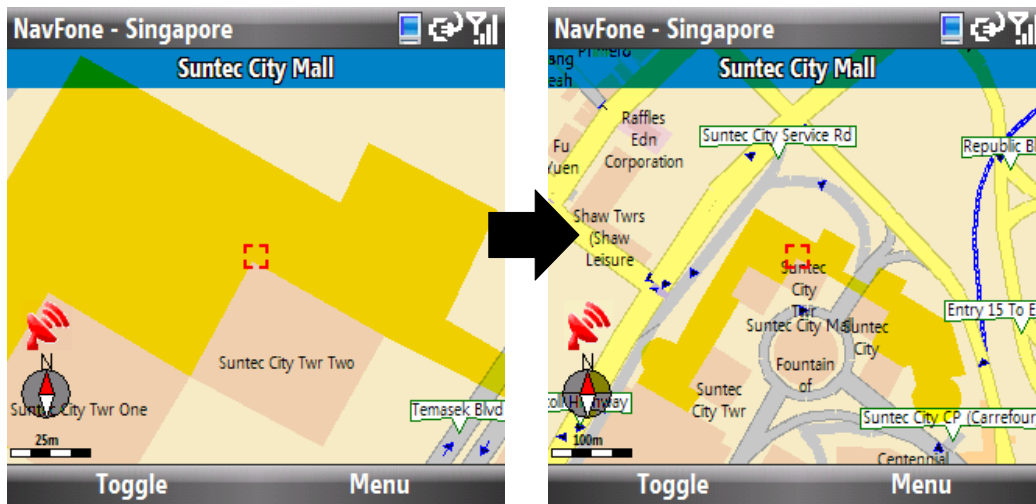
3.1 Basic Map Function

3.1.1 Zoom In



Press “9” or “V” on the keypad to zooms in onto the cursor position.

3.1.2 Zoom Out



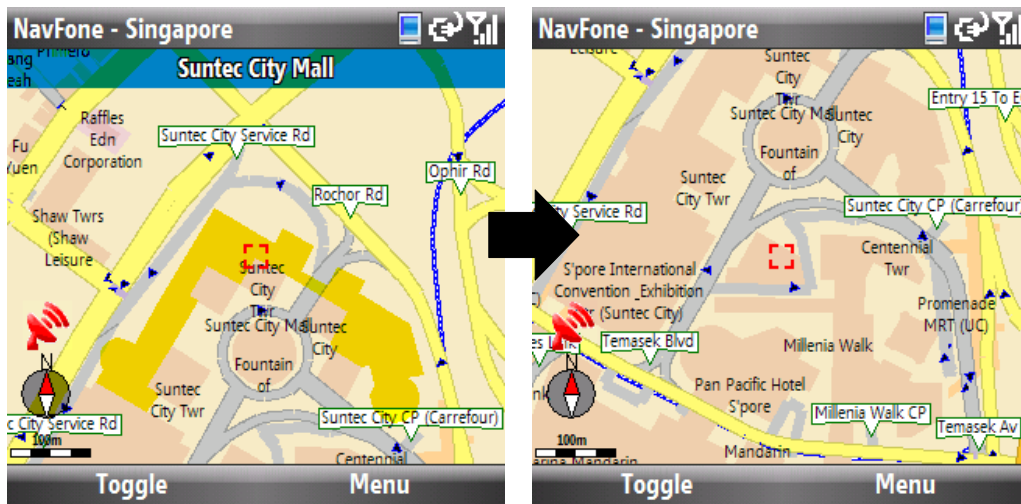
Press **“7”** or **“X”** on the keypad to zooms out of the cursor position.

3.1.3 Pan Up



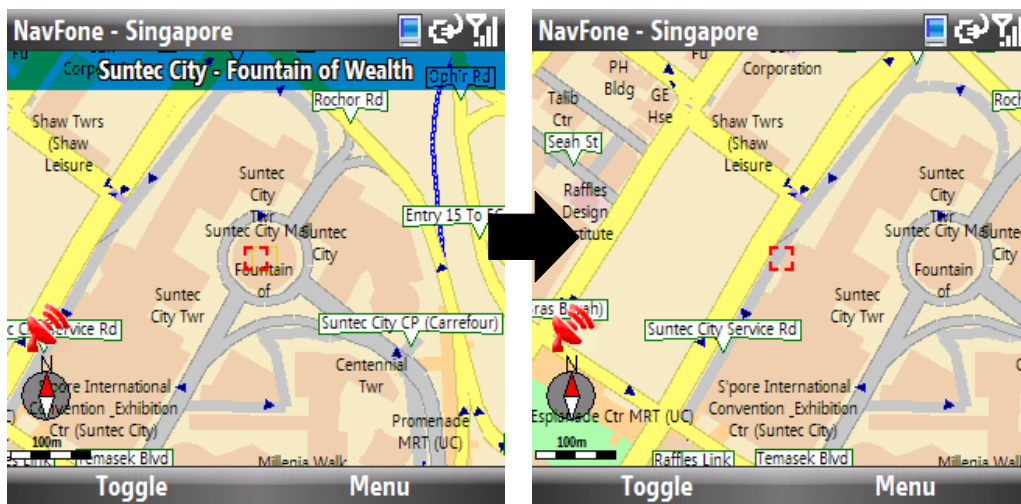
- Moving the cursor upwards will display more map details to the top of the current view.

3.1.4 Pan Down



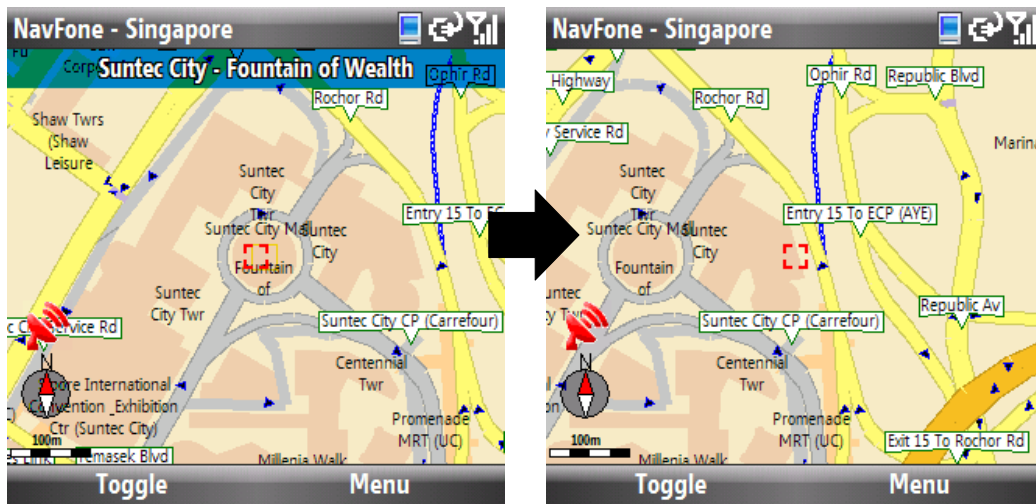
- Moving the cursor downward will display more map details at the bottom of the current view.

3.1.5 Pan Left



- Moving the cursor to the left will display more map details to the left of the current view.
- **Press “4” or “D”** on the keypad will have the same effect.

3.1.6 Pan Right

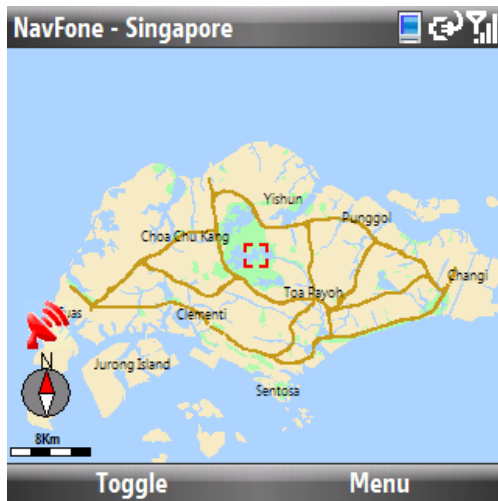


- Moving the cursor to the right will display more map details to the right of the current view.
- **Press “6” or “G”** on the keypad will have the same effect.

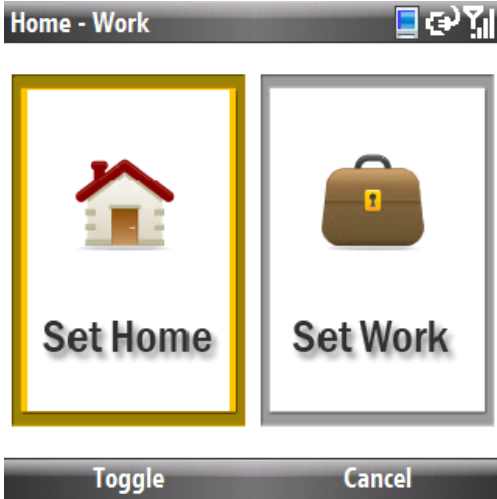
3.2 The Toggle Button

There are two menus in the Map view window.

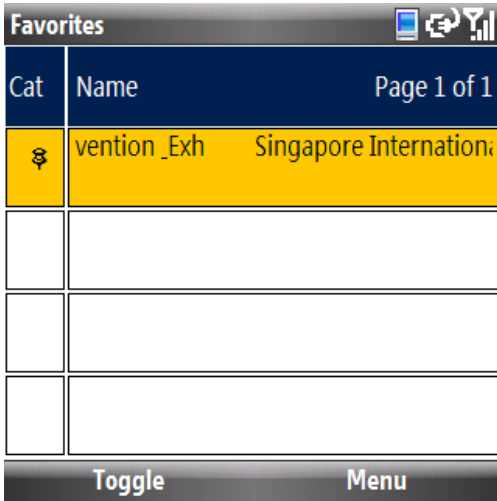
Toggle: Allow switching between various views modes.



Map View (Default View)



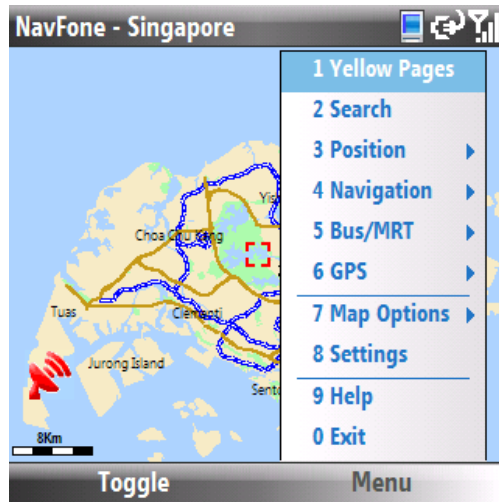
Home/Work Navigation Shortcuts View

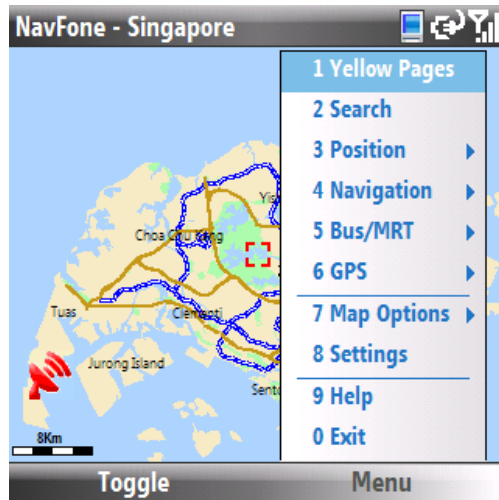

4.0 Search

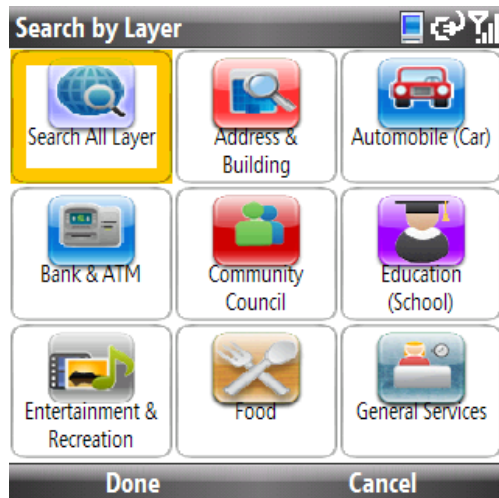
There are 2 types of search available in NAVFone.

4.1 Search Keyword

The first type search command performs a search for locations or map features in the map, based on a keyword or phrase and list them in alphabetical order. Search can be conducted for all layers or a single layer.



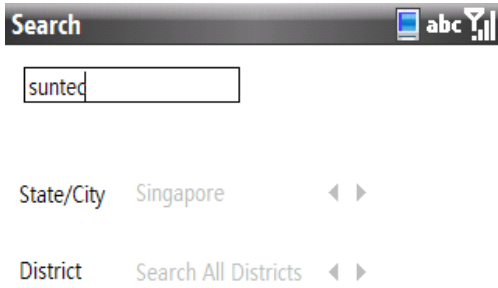

4.2 What's Nearby?

The other search command conducts a search for locations or map features in the vicinity of the current cursor position on the map. No keyword is required for this search, and results are listed with respect to the distance from the cursor. Search can be conducted for all layers or a single layer.



Go to **Menu>Position>What's Nearby**.



Select a search category. To see all results, select Search All Layer.

7.0 Planning Your Route (Drive & Public Transport)

7.1 Route Planning For Driving

A start point and a destination must be clearly defined to successfully plan a route. In NAVFone, there are a few way to set the start point and destination.

7.1.1 Set Start Position

Via GPS Position (Recommended)	The start position will be the current GPS location.
Via Search (including Yellow Pages)	Use the search menu for location lookup
Via Favourite	Choose from the waypoints in the Favourite Manager.

7.1.2 Set Destination

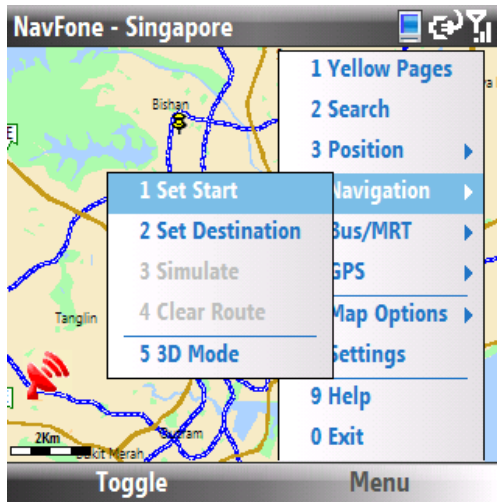
Via Search (including Yellow Pages)	Use the search menu for location lookup
Via Favourite	Choose from the waypoints in the Favourite Manager.

7.1.3 Routing & ERP Cost



The estimated ERP cost is shown, when available, in the Navigation View. The ERP cost is based on the current device time.

7.2 The Navigation Menu



Goto **Map View > Menu > Navigation**

Set Start:

Defines the start point based on cursor position.

Set Destination:

Defines the end point based on cursor position.

Simulate:

Starts or stops the simulation the generated route. During playback, visual indications and voice prompts will be seen & heard.

Select Toggle to switch to the different navigation views

Clear Route:

Removes the generated route.

2D/3D Mode:

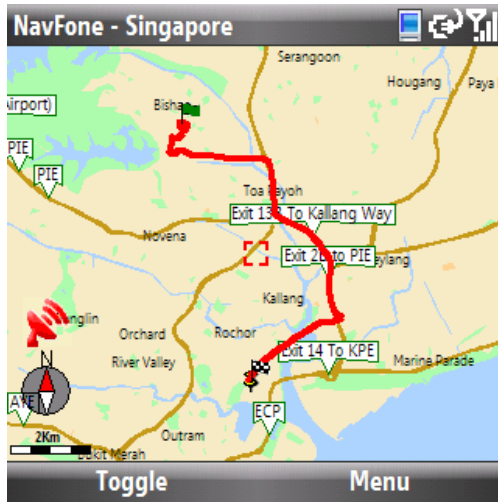
Switches between 2D and 3D map views.

7.3 The Navigation Views

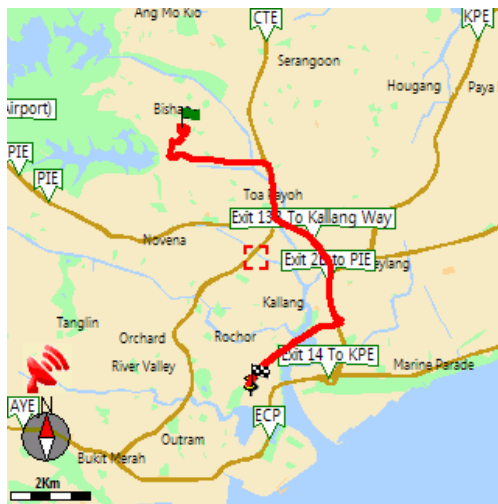
NAVFone features several views which are only available during navigation

The 2D view is the default navigation view. It is available in either Full Screen or non Full Screen.

Taping “5” or “F” on the keypad to toggle the full screen view on or off

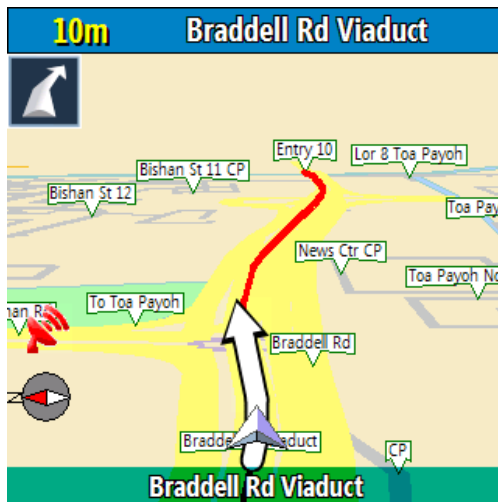
NAVFone also features 3D navigation view. It is also available in either Full Screen or non Full Screen.

Taping “5” or “F” on the keypad to toggle the full screen view on or off

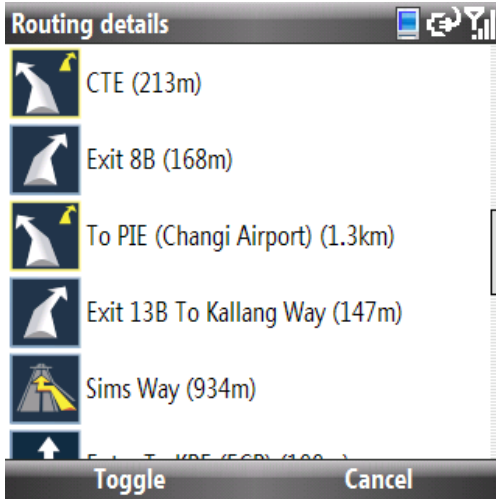
Goto Map View > Menu > Navigation > 3D Mode to enable or disable.



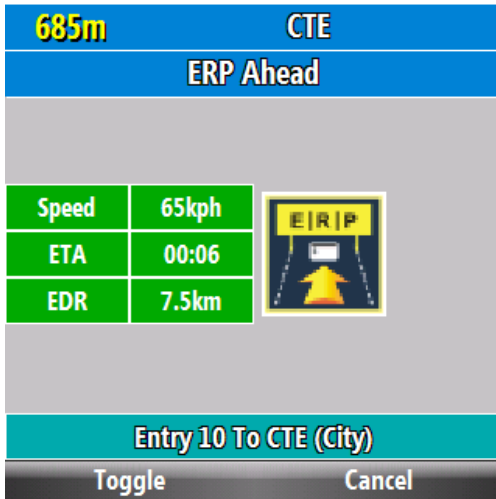
Full Screen View **OFF**

Tap on the Toggle button again to access the Arrow Indicator view.

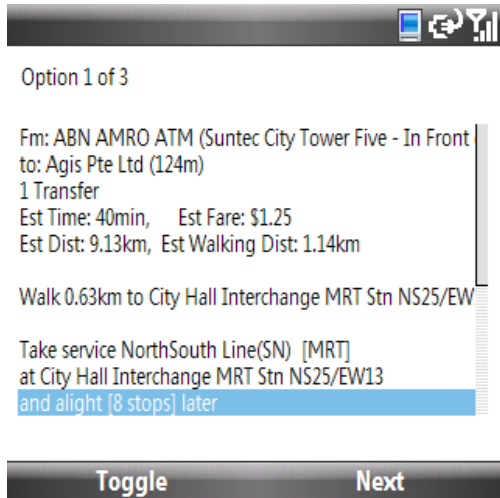
7.4 Routing for Public Transport (Bus/MRT)

Via Favourite	Choose from the waypoints in the Favourite Manager.

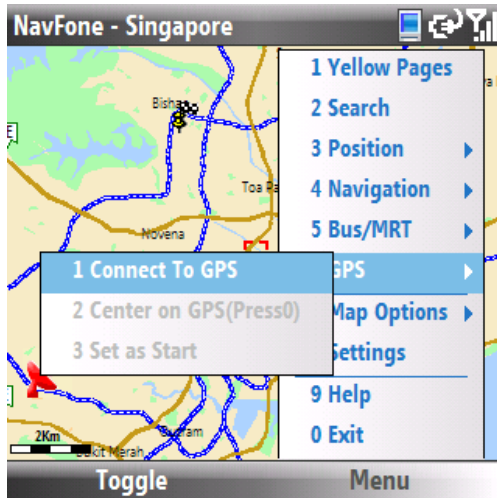


Once the Start Point and End Point are set, the routing detail will be shown. **Press Next/Previous** to browse through the details.

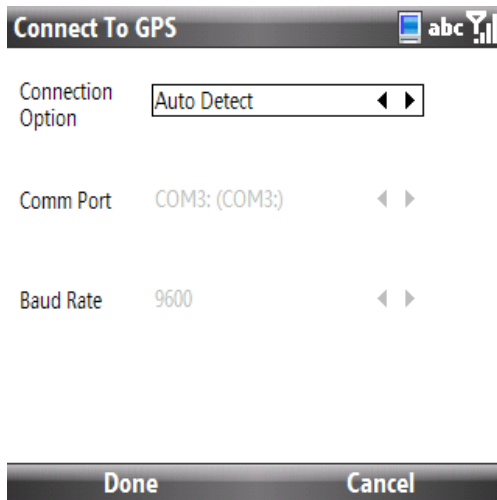
8.0 GPS

NAVFone feature automatic connection to GPS. Note that GPS is only available outdoor.

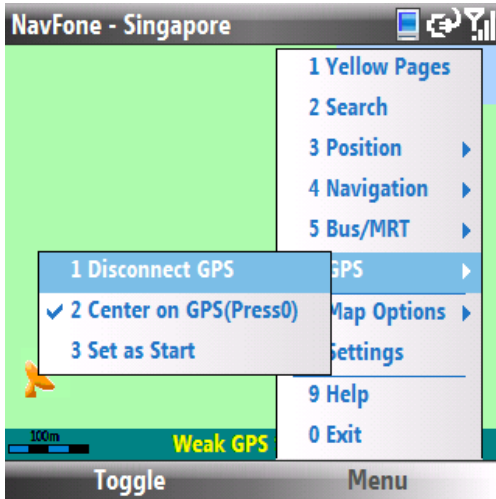
8.1 Managing GPS Connection



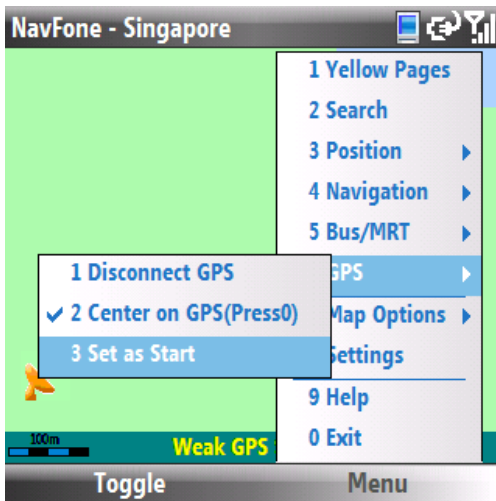
Goto **Map View > Menu > GPS**
Select Connect to GPS.



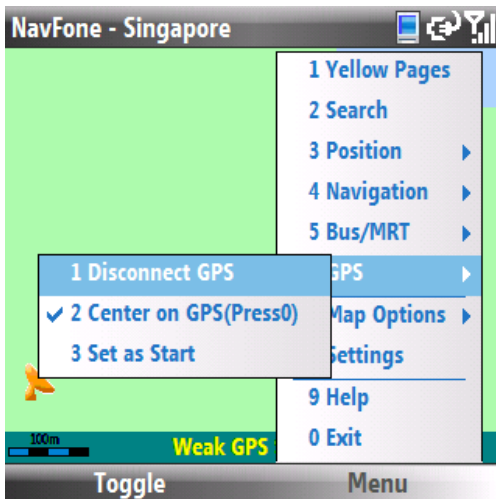
Select Auto Detect and the press **Done**.



Select Center on GPS or press “0” on the keypad to always display your current GPS position on the map.



Select Set as Start to set the current GPS position as the navigation start point.



Select Disconnect GPS to allow NAVFone to disconnect from the GPS receiver.

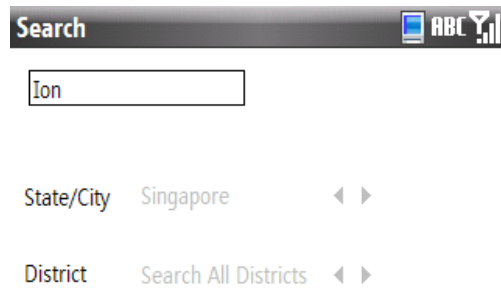
9.0 Favourite Management

Favourite (also known as waypoints) are points that can be created and displayed in the map as an icon with a label attached to it. All waypoint can be saved for later use and easy reference. Each waypoint's label, icon type and size can be set to differentiate one from another. A short note can also add to it.

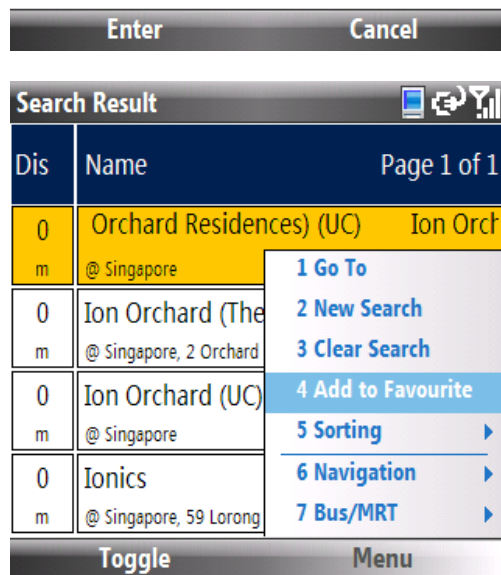
9.1 Acquiring Waypoints

There are 3 methods to add waypoints.

9.1.1 Method 1:



Use the **Search** feature and seek for the desired location.



Once the results are displayed, select the correct result **goto Menu > Add to Favourites.**

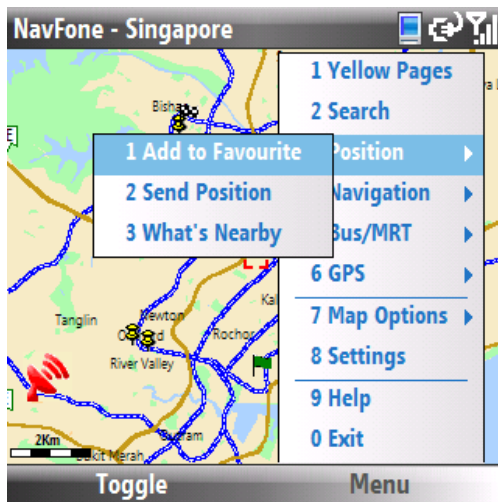

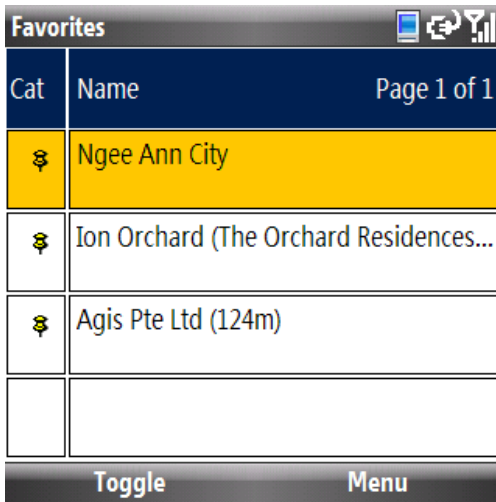

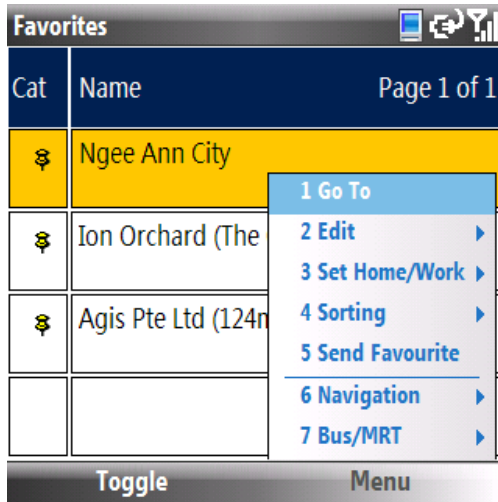
9.2 Favourite Manager

To view the Favourite Manager, **press Toggle** until it appears.

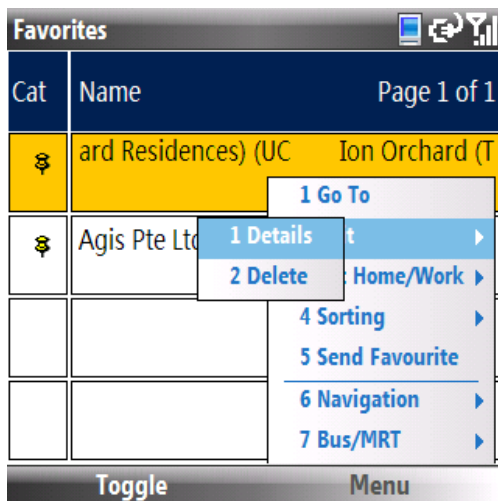
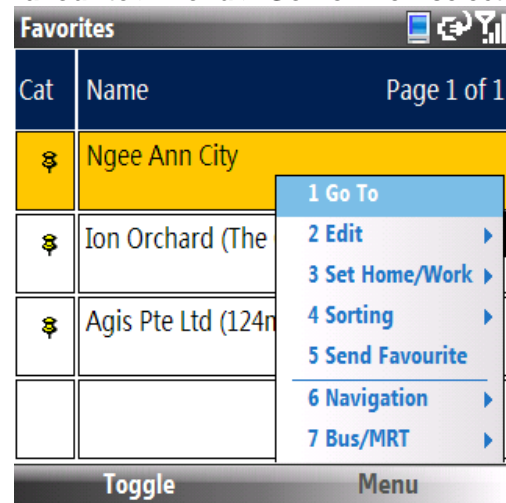

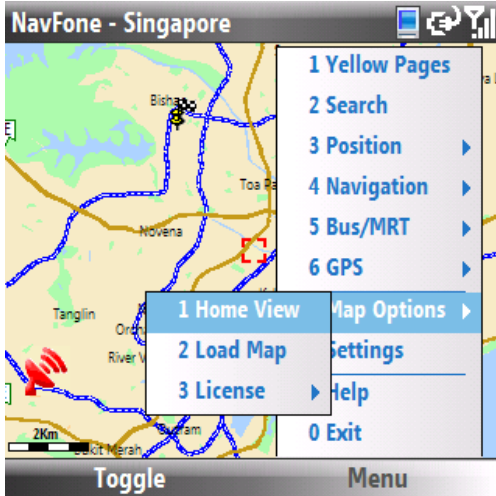

The Home View provides an overview of the selected country map.



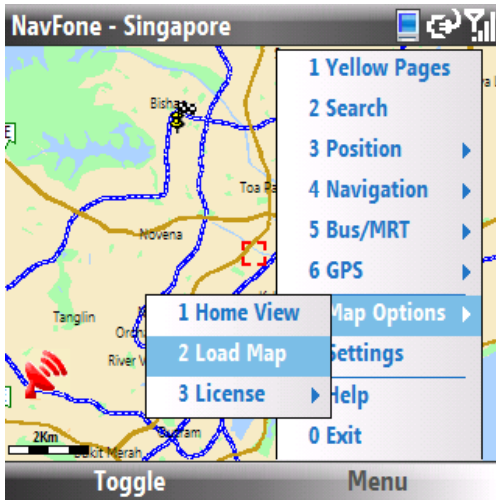

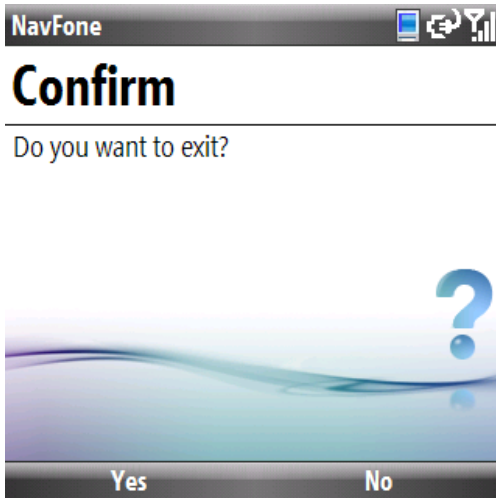
13.0 Exit NAVFone
